CPMS updates



The future CPMS



The development of the new version of CPMS continues. Each ERN has nominated two individuals to be part of the Business Implementation Group (BIG), which will oversee the project and take the high-level decisions. Underneath this, there is a

smaller group of Product Owners drawn from the ERNs who work on the design of the new system more intensively with IBM. ERN eUROGEN delegated Darren Shilhan as a Product Owner, and regular bi-weekly meetings have been taking place from January 2023 onwards.

Thank you to everyone who responded to the survey regarding whether to change the name of CPMS with the introduction of the new version. These results were fed back to the Commission and it is likely the name will change. In the future, there will be further consultation regarding the change.

We expect the new version of CPMS to debut in late 2023 and run alongside the current version for at least 12 months.


The 5-year evaluation & CPMS activity




Those HCPs who are involved in the current 5-year evaluation process will know that one of the requirements was to report your CPMS contribution to the network. All current members will be expected to do

the same in 5-years time.

As a result, we monitor both the CPMS usage in the monthly Performance Report that is sent to all member HCPs.



The take-home messages from this are that, whilst we now have significantly more users than 12 months ago, largely due to our new members, there has been a noticeable decline in new panels created over that same period (although the last five weeks have seen five new panels added).



We are now also monitoring acceptances and contributions to panels, as well as attendances at video meetings.

Good to know



Browsers & CPMS video meetings

If you are joining a CPMS video panel, we would like to advise you not to use Safari to do this. The current version of the system does not work optimally using Safari. We recommend using Chrome where possible, or otherwise Firefox.

Reimbursement protocol

In January 2022, the European Commission announced a pilot for reimbursement for panel activity. Therefore, from March 2022 to August 2023, those who have acted as experts in video panels will be eligible for reimbursement to their HCP for their time. The total reimbursable amount per panel will rise from €200 in the current grant to €500 in the new grant which starts in September 2023.

Running panels



Your panel, your choice



As a panel lead, you have the freedom to tailor your panel to your match your preferences.

Naturally, you can decide which experts to invite to your panel. If you wish to invite someone who is not currently registered on CPMS, let us know and we'll help them join, even if they're not in a eUROGEN HCP.

Furthermore, you can choose whether the contributions from your panel of experts are provided through video meetings or otherwise written directly into the panel page, whether into the Panel Discussion on the right-hand side of the page, or into the Contributions & Outcome tab.



By the way, we'll be creating a 1-page help guide around providing panel contributions in the very near future!

Additionally, we'll work with you to establish a timeline for when you want the panel to be discussed, making it possible for urgent panels to be addressed promptly.

Of course, if you have any other specific requirements, please don't hesitate to get in touch with us. We're always here to brainstorm solutions with you and find the best way forward to suit your needs.

And if something is not possible in the current system, we can request it as a feature in the new version!
