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1. QUESTIONS

Complications within 6 weeks after surgery

8.4 ITEM: Local pain at prosthesis site

Question: Is local pain without intervention (e.g., use of painkillers) also considered a complication? **Answer**: Yes, any type of pain in the affected area is a complication.

Question: Can I register complications beyond 6 weeks after surgery anywhere?

Answer: Yes, but only if the AMS800 was activated 6 weeks after surgery (ITEM 8.8).

Complications within 3 months after activation

8.9.2 ITEM: Local pain at prosthesis site

Question: Is local pain without intervention (e.g., use of painkillers) also considered a complication? **Answer**: Yes, any type of pain in the affected area is a complication.

8.9.5 ITEM: Mechanical failure

Question: Is mechanical failure due to an incorrect fit of the cuff (e.g., too loose, too big) considered a complication? **Answer**: Yes.

Question: How do I complete the section on complications within 3 months after surgery if a patient has had a revision within that period?

Answer: You can select what the patient was suffering from which led to the revision.

Question: Is it correct that there is no item on retention in the section Complications within 3 months after surgery? **Answer**: Yes, this is correct. Retention is no longer expected after activation of the AMS800 device.

Last visit evaluation

8.12 ITEM: Revision

Question: The patient has had multiple revisions, is it possible to register more than one?

Answer: Yes. After having registered the first revision, the Snapshot will ask you if another revision has taken place. You can register up to 5 revisions.



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
