ERN eUROGEN registry Report on Common Data Elements

INTRODUCTION


This report shows the number of patients entered retrospectively in the ERN eUROGEN registry for five Expertise Area's with a finished Clinical Practice Snapshot. The included Expertise Area's are 1.5 Posterior urethral valves, 1.7 Anorectal malformations, 2.1 Complicated and complex pelvic floor disorders: AMS800 device, 3.2 Testicular cancer and 3.3 Adrenal tumors. Currently, the ERN eUROGEN registry includes almost 1000, but only over 400 patients are included in the current analysis. The remaining patients are either prospectively registered patients, patients for Expertise Area's without a Clinical Practice Snapshot or patients without a completed Clinical Practice Snapshot for one of the five Expertise Area's in this analysis. Only the HCPs who completely entered 5 retrospectively collected patients for one of the Expertise Areas for which the Clinical Practice Snapshot was developed, are included in this report.
